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**Filing Dates for Saturday May 2, 2020
City of Alvin General Election**

The next General Election for the City of Alvin will be on Saturday, May 2, 2020. Voters will consider the election of a Mayor and a member to City Council District E. Filing for a place on this ballot will run from Wednesday, January 15 – Friday, February 14, 2020.

Qualifications for Office (*on the day prior to the date of the scheduled election*):

- be at least eighteen years of age
- be a citizen of the United States
- be a qualified voter of the city
- have been a resident of the State of Texas for at least twelve (12) consecutive months
- have been a resident of this city and the district for which they seek election, for at least six (6) months.

The terms of office are for three (3) years. A City Council district map can be found on the city's website www.alvin-tx.gov / City Government / City Council / Council Districts Map.
