Alvin Launches Downtown Business Improvement Grant Program

(City Hall, Alvin, TX) The City of Alvin has introduced a Downtown Business Improvement Grant Program for new and existing businesses. The purpose of this program is to promote the development and expansion of new and existing business enterprises within the downtown area of Alvin and to enhance the economic welfare of the citizens of the City. Our goal is to see improvements that will be visible to the citizens and patrons. This will aid in securing and retaining business enterprises and maintaining a higher level of employment, economic activity, and stability. The program is a 50/50 matching grant. The grant allows for businesses to apply for a 50% match on downtown business improvements, reimbursable following completion of approved improvements. The City of Alvin has allocated \$25,000 for the first year of the grant program.
