Alvin Municipal Court Earns Award

Austin—The Texas Municipal Courts Education Center’s (TMCEC) Municipal Traffic Safety Initiatives (MTSI) grant, funded by the Texas Department of Transportation, recently sponsored a traffic safety awards competition to recognize those municipal courts that have demonstrated outstanding contributions in traffic safety.

The State’s guidelines required to receive this award are based on the entity’s implementation of activities relating to increasing traffic safety; while preventing impaired driving traffic crashes, traffic fatalities, juvenile DUI, child safety seat offenses, red light running, and other traffic related offenses. Only ten courts, serving less than 30,000 people, in the State of Texas- received this award; with the Alvin Municipal Court being one of the award winners.
