If you have water in your home and can get out, please go to the shelter at the Living Stones Church (1407 Victory Lane). However, if you do not have water in your home, residents are encouraged to stay off of the roadways. Please know that just because a street isn't listed below, doesn't mean that there isn't high water. We are trying to get the information out as best as we can.

- FM 2234 CLOSED from State Highway 288 West to County Line
- FM 1459 CLOSED from State Highway 35 North to FM 1301
- FM 524 CLOSED from State Highway 35 North to FM 1301
- FM 523 CLOSED at County Road 44 to FM 521
- SH35 CLOSED at Chocolate Bayou
