WHEN IS IT?

Sessions will be held once a week for 6 weeks from 6:00-8:00 p.m. beginning Monday, October 8, 2018.

Each session includes a presentation and hands on demonstrations from one or more City employees at a different city facility each week. On Thursday, November 15th, participants will be recognized as Graduates of Alvin Upfront at the City Council Meeting.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

Classes are open to those who are:

- At least a senior in high school at AISD
- A resident of Alvin, a student enrolled at Alvin Community College, or an owner of a business located in Alvin

HOW DO I APPLY?

Applications will be available online and at City Hall during the application period from **August 13 – September 20**. The class is limited to a maximum of 25 participants.

WHAT DO I NEED TO BRING?

A willingness to participate! Refreshments and class materials will be provided.

HOW CAN I BE SUCCESSFUL?

- Participants who miss more than one session will not receive a graduation certificate.
- Participants are encouraged to take part in class discussions, but are asked to refrain from using the sessions to discuss personal grievances or issues.
